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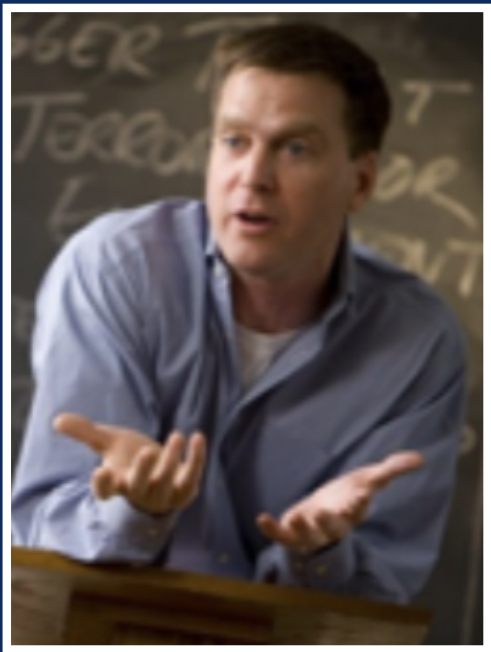
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### SPEAKER BIOS

#### **Jamie Freuh**

Associate Provost, Bridgewater College



Jamie Freuh has been teaching at Bridgewater College since 2002, and is currently Professor of Global Politics and Director of the Center for Engaged Learning. His bachelor's degree from Georgetown University's School of Foreign Service and his doctorate in International Relations is from the School of International Service at American University. He has published on the political identity of the South African transition from apartheid, on the social construction of agency, and on the pedagogy of politics. His most recent book is *Pedagogical Journeys through World Politics*, an edited volume of auto-ethnographic essays by 23 experienced IR scholars laying out their philosophical and practical development as teachers of global politics. Jamie has run numerous teaching workshops in the United States and internationally, and is the recipient of the International Studies Association 2019 Melissa Gerner Innovative Teaching Award.
